WHAT IS RECRUITMENT FRAUD?

Recruitment fraud is a sophisticated scam offering fake job opportunities to job seekers. This type of fraud is normally carried out through online services such as false websites, or through fake e-mails claiming to be from the company. The fraudsters often request recipients to provide personal information and to make payments as part of their fake recruiting process. We will never ask for sensitive personal and financial information before a job offer has been accepted. Sensitive employee information is never requested via email.

HOW TO IDENTIFY RECRUITMENT FRAUD

- 1. All domestic applicants are required to **only** apply for open positions through <u>www.accurusaero.com</u>.
- 2. Fraudulent job offers often ask for financial or personal information early in the process. We do not ask for any financial information or contribution from a candidate at any stage of the recruitment process.
- 3. A fraudulent offer may ask you to book travel through a certain travel agency with the promise to reimburse travel costs.
